**WAIVER OF LIABILITY FOR ALL CLAIMS AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

The Organization: **Red Rose Ranch – May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024**

Completed waivers must be returned prior to entry and use of the Organization’s facilities.

By signing below, the participant (named below) or the participant’s Guardian understands and acknowledges, the risks, dangers, and hazards which are inherent on entering all lands, properties, facilities, structures, installations, vehicles or equipment owned, leased, operated or otherwise controlled by the Organization (the “Premises”), which risk include, but are not limited to: the potential for bodily injury or illness; contact or interaction with others who may have been exposed to a communicable illness; close proximity to or contact with surfaces, equipment, fixtures, or other objects that, despite the Organization’s efforts, may be infected with communicable illnesses; permanent disability, paralysis, or loss of life; collision with natural or manmade objects; tripping hazards; imperfect venue or field of play conditions; equipment failure; participants of varying skill levels; the negligent use of the Premises by others; inadequate safety measures or unsafe Premises; other circumstances known, unknown or beyond the control of the Organizer, its partners, sponsors, agents, affiliates, owners, employees, staff, or volunteers (together, the “Releases”); or negligence or omission of the Releases (collectively, the “Risks”).

In consideration for allowing the participant to use the Premises, the participant: (a) releases, discharges and forever holds harmless the Releases from any and all liability for damages or loss arising as a result of the Risks arising from entry into or use of the Premises; (b) waive any right to sue the Releases in respect of all causes of action (including for injuries or illness caused by their own negligence), claims, damages or losses of any kind that may arise as a result of the Risks or in connection with entry into or use of the Premises, including without limitation the right to make a third party claim or claim over against the Releases arising from the same; and (c) freely assumes all risks associated with the Risks or anything to the Risks, which may arise as a result of or in connection with use of the Premises. **YOU ARE GIVING UP LEGAL RIGHTS TO ANY AND ALL FUTURE CLAIMS AGAINST THE ORGANIZATION AND RELEASES.**

## Red Rose Ranch Horsemanship Clinic Rules

1. Manitoba Horse Council (MHC) 2024 membership is required.
2. Administration will be done electronically only. **Deadline is May 7th, 2024, at 6:00PM:**

3. Be considerate to others, both people and horses, no exceptions. Treat others (including horses and property) with the same kindness and respect with which you would like to be treated.
4. Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated.
5. Cruel and inhumane treatment of animals will not be tolerated.
6. No smoking in or near the barn or any buildings. Smoking area will be designated.
7. Parking is located east of the bunkhouse and will be designated.
8. The outhouse is our restroom on the ranch and is located between the bunkhouse and arena.
9. First Aid Kits are in the barn for self care. Notify staff immediately of any injuries.
10. Fire extinguishers are in the barn for immediate emergencies. Notify ALL immediately of any fires. Muster point will be in the parking lot.
11. Please notify staff of any necessary repairs, maintenance, problems, or needed supplies so that repairs may be made or problems remedied as soon as possible.
12. Clean up after your horse and yourself. There are trash containers, shovels, brooms, and muck buckets available for the disposal of manure, hair, hoof cleanings and general refuse.
13. Horses are not to be left unattended while tied to a fence, trailer, or crossties.
14. Dogs must be on a controlled leash or secured in a kennel.
